ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On May 18, 1965, an Order Setting Hearing in this proceeding was issued in accordance with recommendations of the Commission's Transportation Division that a hearing be held for the receipt of evidence pertaining to rates, charges and rules governing the transportation of water in vacuum-type or pump-type tank vehicles to steam plant sites located in oil fields.

To date no action has been taken pursuant to said Order Setting Hearing.

This phase of Case No. 6008 should not be carried indefinitely on the Commission's docket. It will be dismissed.

IT IS ORDERED that the Order Setting Hearing, dated May 18, 1965, in Case No. 6008 is dismissed.
