BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Application of VENTURA COUNTY RAILWAY COMPANY to construct a spur line across Hueneme Road, a county road, at Port Hueneme, California

Application No. 48497

O R D E R

The Ventura County Railway Company is hereby authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Hueneme Road in Ventura County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 45-3.59-C.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, and of a width of 26 feet and with grades of approach not exceeding one percent in accordance with plan attached to the application. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 3 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B). Trains shall not be operated over the crossing until such protection is placed in service.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless

time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. Applicant alleges that the crossing is needed to provide immediate service to a warehouse.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
