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SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Haslett Warehouse Company, a corporation, possesses certificates of public convenience and necessity issued by this Commission to operate as a highway common carrier and a public utility warehouseman. On April 7, 1966, applicant filed with this Commission its amended articles of incorporation changing its corporate name to Haslett Company. Accordingly, the certificates involved in the above proceedings will be amended to show the new corporate name, and applicant will be ordered to amend its tariffs pursuant to the Commission's General Orders Nos. 61-A and 80-A. Various other public utility warehouse operative rights of applicant will be amended by separate order. A public hearing is not necessary.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Decision No. 62834 dated November 21, 1961, in Application No. 43259 and Decision No. 64585 dated December 4, 1962, in Application No. 44874 are amended by substituting "Haslett Company" in lieu of "Haslett Warehouse Company."

2. Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public, Haslett Company shall amend its tariffs on file with this Commission as required by Rules Nos. 6.2 and 6.4 of General Orders Nos. 61-A and 80-A, respectively.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
