ORDER REINSTATING OPERATING AUTHORITIES
AND EXTENDING TIME FOR PAYMENT OF FINE

It appears that by Decision No. 70025, issued herein November 30, 1965, which became effective December 28, 1965, respondent Terminal Transportation Co., Inc. was ordered to pay a fine of \$2,223.64, on or before January 17, 1966; and

By Resolution No. 15105, dated May 3, 1966, the radial highway common carrier permit and city carrier permit, issued to Terminal Transportation Co., Inc. were suspended by reason of its failure to pay said fine; and

By letter, dated May 18, 1966, said Terminal Transportation Co., Inc. submitted a check in the amount of \$305.91 in partial payment of said fine, promised to pay the balance of said fine on or before May 18, 1967, and requested reinstatement of its operating authorities; now therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The suspension of the operating authorities of Terminal Transportation Co., Inc., respondent herein, provided in Resolution No. 15105, dated May 3, 1966, is terminated, and the operating authorities issued to Terminal Transportation Co., Inc. by Radial Highway Common Carrier Permit No. 19-56607 and City Carrier Permit No. 19-56608, issued on June 4, 1963, are reinstated.

2. The time within which respondent Terminal Transportation Co., Inc. shall pay the balance of the fine in the amount of \$1,917.73 pursuant to paragraph 1 of the order in Decision No. 70025, dated November 30, 1965, in Case No. 8073, is extended to May 18, 1967.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
