ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE AUTHORITY

By Decision No. 69082 dated May 18, 1965, in Application No. 47355 and by Decision No. 70300 dated February 1, 1966, in Application No. 48078, Ruben Earl Williams was granted a passenger stage operative right authorizing service between the B O P (General Motors) Assembly Plant in the City of Fremont and the City of Oakland and intermediate points, and it appearing that during the month of January 1966, Ruben Earl Williams, without appropriate authority, discontinued the passenger stage service theretofore conducted by him between the aforementioned points pursuant to the foregoing described operative right, and that since March 5, 1966, Ruben Earl Williams has had no evidence on file with this Commission showing adequate protection against liability imposed by law for payment of damage for personal injury or property damage, as required by General Order No. 101-A, and that Ruben Earl Williams has stated that service was discontinued because of the irregularity of working hours for employees of the assembly plant which made it impossible to accommodate a sufficient number of passengers on a particular bus schedule; and that Ruben Earl Williams has failed to file an annual report of his operations for the year 1965 as required by Section 584 of the Public Utilities Code; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the passenger stage operative rights, created by Decision No. 69082 in Application No. 47355 and by Decision No. 70300 in Application No. 48078, are hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Ruben Earl Williams are hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Ruben Earl Williams or to mail a certified copy thereof to Ruben Earl Williams at 1265 82nd Avenue, Oakland, California, last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the 30th day after such service upon Ruben Earl Williams or after the above mailing to Ruben Earl Williams, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission written response to this order requesting public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
