O R D E R

The Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to construct a drill track at grade across Arctic Circle and Molette Street in the City of Santa Fe Springs, Los Angeles County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as Crossings Nos. BK-501.13-C and BK-501.39-C, respectively.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Construction of each crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width of 52 feet, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two percent in accordance with plan attached to the application. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 3 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-2), at each crossing. Trains shall not be operated over the crossing until such protection is placed in service.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless

time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
