O P I N I O N

Square Deal Trucking Corporation requests that its certified authority as a highway common carrier be suspended for a period of 150 days.

Applicant is authorized to transport general commodities, with certain exceptions, between all points and places within the Los Angeles Basin Territory and between all said points, on the one hand, and all points and places on and along U. S. Highways 101 and 101-A south of the Basin Territory to the California-Mexican Border, on the other hand. Such operative authority was granted by Decision No. 60574 dated August 16, 1960, as amended by Decision No. 63090 dated January 9, 1962.

It is alleged that applicant corporation is presently engaged in certain litigation brought by one of the stockholders which if successful would result in the following:

- (a) Involuntary dissolution of applicant;
- (b) Removal of directors and officers;
- (c) Appointment of receiver pendente lite; and
- (d) Appointment by the Court of a proper person or persons to act as Trustee or Trustees of said corporation in dissolution.

It is further alleged that the principal asset of the corporation is the above-mentioned certificate of public convenience

and necessity which might be considered abandoned for non-use during such litigation.

After consideration the Commission finds that the requested suspension would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The authority granted by Decision No. 60574 in Application No. 42101 and as amended by Decision No. 63090 is hereby suspended for a period of 150 days after the effective date hereof.

2. All effective tariff schedules of such carrier filed pursuant to the certificate granted and amended by the decisions referred to above are hereby suspended. Suspension supplements to tariff schedules so suspended are not required and shall not be filed.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
