O R D E R

The City of Los Angeles is hereby authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Neptune Avenue at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6M-20.59-C, in the City of Los Angeles.

Applicant shall bear the entire construction expense, also maintenance cost of the crossing.

Width of the crossing shall not exceed 48 feet and grades of approach shall be not greater than three percent in accordance with plan attached to the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) with reflex reflecting sheet material. Trains shall not be operated over the crossing until such protection has been placed in service.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless

time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
