ORDER

The City of Los Angeles is hereby authorized to construct Kinsey Drive at Exposition Boulevard and University Avenue (vacated) at Exposition Boulevard at grade across the track of the Southern Pacific Company, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as Crossings Nos. 6A-4.96 and 6A-5.07, respectively, in the City of Los Angeles.

Width of each crossing shall be 46 feet and grades of approach shall be not greater than three percent in accordance with plan attached to the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection at Kinsey Drive at Exposition Boulevard (Crossing No. 6A-4.96) shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) and protection at University Avenue (vacated) at Exposition Boulevard (Crossing No. 6A-5.07) shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) with reflex-reflecting sheet material.

Traffic signals at Kinsey Drive (Crossing No. 6A-4.96) shall be coordinated with the automatic crossing protection.

Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost of the crossings outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossings between such lines. The maintenance costs of automatic crossing protection shall be borne by applicant, pursuant to the provisions of Section 1202.2 of the Public Utilities Code.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
