OPINION AND ORDER

Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2, City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A and Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 1-B, 5 and 9-B name minimum rates and rules for the transportation of general commodities by highway carriers statewide, city carriers within San Francisco and city carriers and highway carriers between points in the East Bay, Los Angeles and San Diego drayage areas, respectively. By these petitions, as amended, California Trucking Association seeks to have established in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 and to have revised in the four drayage tariffs provisions pertaining to the free return of pallets. Petitioner asks that all common carriers be authorized to establish in their respective tariffs all such modifications as may be prescribed

by the Commission's orders in these proceedings, including relief from the long- and short-haul provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code.

Petitioner proposes that empty pallets be returned from point of destination of the palletized shipment to point of origin without charge under the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 when (1) such empty pallets are immediately provided by the consignee to the carrier upon receipt of the palletized shipment; (2) the palletized shipment is transported under certain truckload rates and subject to a minimum weight of not less than 20,000 pounds;¹ (3) the palletized shipment is loaded into carrier's equipment by the consignor and/or unloaded from such equipment by the consignee with power equipment furnished and used without expense to the carrier; and (4) the shipper and/or consignee complies with certain documentation requirements. Petitioner also suggests minor changes in the drayage tariffs, which will have the effect of uniformity with the proposal for Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2.

Petitioner alleges that recent informal interpretations by the Commission's Transportation Division concerning the transportation of pallets have prompted substantial inquiry into the adequacy of the current tariff provisions.² Petitioner further alleges that a broad program of shipper and carrier discussions on various phases of the problem has been instituted and it has become immediately obvious from such discussions that the present provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 do not afford sufficient incentive for maximum use

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These rates are set forth in Items Nos. 320, 338, 345, 350, 360 and 390 of Tariff No. 2 and apply to the transportation of canned goods, animal feed, foodstuffs, dehydrated, dried or evaporated fruit, groceries and grocers' supplies and sugar.

of palletization. Petitioner states that the economics of short-haul transportation would permit the return transportation of pallets without charge when certain qualifications are met.

Petitioner asserts that the proposed tariff modifications in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 will permit the free return of pallets under certain conditions, will provide an incentive for shipper cooperation in palletization of truck shipments and will promote efficiencies and economies in carrier operations and that the revisions in the drayage tariffs will provide consistency with improved technical knowledge. Petitioner avers that such tariff changes will result in no increases.

Copies of the verified petitions and amendments were mailed to various chambers of commerce, shipper organizations and carrier representatives on or about April 15 and May 13, 1966. The petitions and amendments were listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of April 19 and May 17, 1966, respectively. No objection to the granting of the petitions, as amended, has been received.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that petitioner's proposal is reasonable and consistent with the public interest, and that such proposal will produce just, reasonable and nondiscriminatory rates and charges. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the petitions, as amended, should be granted. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 will be amended accordingly by the order herein. In order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution, City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A and Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 1-B, 5 and 9-B will be amended by separate order.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 (Appendix "D" to Decision No. 31606, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective September 24, 1966, the revised pages attached hereto and listed in Appendix A, also attached hereto, which pages and appendix are by this reference made a part hereof.

2. Tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order, and may be made effective on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order.

3. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the rules authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the rules published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

4. In all other respects Decision No. 31606, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
