## QRDER

County of San Joaquin is hereby authorized to reconstruet the crossing of Louise Avenue at grade with a track of Iidewater Southern Railway Company, identified as Crossing No. 75B-3.7, near Manteca, San Jeaquin County, as described and substantially as shown in the application. Width of crossing shall be not less than thirty-two feet and grades of approach not greater than one percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard Ne. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standame No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material.

Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines twe feet outside of rails. Tidewater Southern Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines.
