In the Matter of the Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing construction at grade of an industrial drill track and an industrial spur across Griffith Street, in the City of San Leandro, County of Alameda, State of California.

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to construct two spur tracks at grade across Griffith Street in the City of San Leandro, County of Alameda, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. L-16.8-C. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72 without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding three percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This

authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The client that will be served by this spur track has written to indicate the urgent nature of this matter. ✓
