O R D E R


This is an application for an order of the Commission authorizing Associated Freight Lines to execute a Security Agreement. The agreement will encumber the carrier's certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by this Commission and certificate of registration issued by the Interstate Commerce Commission as additional collateral for the indebtedness authorized by Decision No. 69062, dated May 18, 1965, in Application No. 47548.


After consideration we find that the proposed Security Agreement will not be adverse to the public interest. On the basis of this finding we conclude that the application should be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.


IT IS ORDERED that Associated Freight Lines may execute a Security Agreement in the same form, or in substantially the same form, as that attached to the application as Exhibit A.
