O R D E R

The Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Mount Vernon Avenue in the City of Pomona, County of Los Angeles, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. B-512.16-C.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width of 30 feet, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one percent in accordance with plan attached to the application. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material. Trains shall not be operated over the crossing until such protection is placed in service.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless

time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. Applicant alleges that spur track is needed to supply immediate service to a plant.


