ORDER OF DISMISSAL


Decision No. 70767, dated May 24, 1966, in this proceeding, extended to December 31, 1966, the expiration date governing a 10 percent allowance from the applicable mileage rates in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 6-A for certain shipments of asphalt and road oil in bulk in tank truck equipment.




IT IS ORDERED that Petition for Modification No. 75 in Case No. 5436 is dismissed.
