Application No. 48703 ORDER Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to construct a spur track at grade across California Avenue at Los Medanos near the City of Pittsburg in Contra Costa County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No.B-51.52-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the avenue now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding three percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. No train, engine, motor or car shall be operated over said crossing unless it shall be first brought to a stop. Suitable signs calling attention of trainmen to the above restriction shall be erected adjacent to the track of said crossing. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order. applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be 1 -

A.48703 hc extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.
