Application of THE ATCHISON, TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILWAY COMPANY, a corporation, for authority to extend its existing lead tracks across Warner Avenue in the City of Tustin, County of Orange, State of California, and thereafter maintain and operate said extension.

## ORDER

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is hereby authorized to construct two lead tracks at grade across Warner Avenue in the Cities of Tustin and Santa Ana, Orange County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 2-178.8-C.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, and of a width of 64 feet, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one percent in accordance with plan attached to the application. Since Warner Avenue has recently been widened protection shall be by four Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B). Backlights may be omitted from the signals located on the median. Trains shall not be operated over the crossing until such protection is placed in service.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. Applicant alleges that the crossing is needed to provide immediate service to a warehouse.
