SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 71216, dated August 30, 1966, in this proceeding, the expiration date of October 1, 1966, governing a surcharge of one cent per 100 pounds in the rates named in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 10 was extended to December 31, 1966.

It has come to the Commission's attention that a lapse of one week occurs between the expiration date of the current surcharge and the effective date of the extension of such surcharge. This was not intended and the necessary correction will be made by the order herein.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Decision No. 71216, dated August 30, 1966, in Case No. 5440 is amended by substituting the following paragraphs in place and stead of Ordering Paragraphs Nos. 1 and 2 thereof:
 - "I. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 10 (Appendix A of Decision No. 44633, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective October 1, 1966, Supplement No. 3 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof."

- "2. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the third day after the effective date of this order on not less than three days' notice to the Commission and to the public and shall be made effective not later than October 1, 1966."
- 2. In all other respects, Decision No. 44633, as amended, and Decision No. 71216 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
