Application of the County of Shasta, for an order authorizing the widening of an existing crossing at separated grades whereby County Road No. 4G02 is carried over the tracks of the Southern Pacific Company in Shasta County, referred to as "Lake Boulevard Overhead".

O R D E R

County of Shasta is hereby authorized to widen an existing crossing at separated grades of County Road 4G02 (Lake Boulevard) over tracks of Southern Pacific Company, near Redding, Shasta County, at the location and substantially as shown by plans (Exhibit B) attached to the application, identified as Crossing No. C-260.8-A. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Clearances shall be in accordance with General Order No. 26-D, except that during the period of construction, a clearance of not less than 20'6" above top of rail is authorized and Southern Pacific Company is authorized to operate with such reduced overhead clearance provided it issues, and files with the Commission, appropriate bulletins to train and engine men advising them of the temporarily impaired clearance condition and forbidding train men

to ride on the tops of cars while operating beneath the structure.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
