O R D E R

The City of Riverside is hereby authorized to reconstruct the existing grade separation of Olivewood Avenue (Crossing No. 3-55.9-A) over the track of the Union Pacific Railroad Company in the City of Riverside as described and in the manner as shown in the application.

Clearances shall be in accordance with those specified in General Order No. 26-D during and after construction.

Construction and maintenance costs shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the City of Riverside and the Union Pacific Railroad Company, and a copy of said executed agreement, together with plans approved by the railroad, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencement of construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the costs by further order.

This project was assigned Priority No. 23 on 1966 Grade Separation List by Decision No. 70134 in Case No. 8264, pursuant to Section 139 of the Streets and Highway Code.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
