SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 70757 dated May 24, 1966, in the above proceeding provided, among other things, for transfer of the exception rating on commodities listed under the heading of "Confectionery" in Exception Ratings Tariff No. 1 from said exception sheet to Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5. Concurrently therewith, the commodity descriptions were revised by directly relating them to items in the National Motor Freight Classification, which describes the same articles for classification purposes.

It has come to the Commission's attention that icing powder was not included in the listing under the heading "Confectionery" in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5. The necessary amendment of this listing will be made by the order herein.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5 (Appendix A of Decision No. 32504, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein to become effective November 6, 1966, Fifteenth Revised Page 5 and Eighth Revised Page 22-A attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. Tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not

earlier than the tenth day after the effective date of this order, and may be made effective on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order.





3. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the rating authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the rating published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing the long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

4. In all other respects, Decision No. 32504, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
