ORDER REVOKING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

Irwin E. Farrar, J. C. Loomis, Hillas F. Cole and W. N. Parkhurst, doing business as Farrar-Loomis Seed Co., possess a prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman at Hemet.

Hillas F. Cole has informed the Commission by letter that the partnership was dissolved and the Farrar-Loomis Seed Co. was sold in December of 1964. He states, to the best of his knowledge, that the new owner has never conducted any warehousing business.

Irwin E. Farrar, J. C. Loomis, Hillas F. Cole and W. N. Parkhurst having discontinued service as a public utility warehouseman without proper authority, the Commission finds that such discontinuance of service constitutes good cause for the revocation of the prescriptive warehouse operative right involved and cancellation of the tariff applicable to the service thereunder.

IT IS ORDERED that:


1. The prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman possessed by Irwin E. Farrar, J. C. Loomis, Hillas F. Cole and W. N. Parkhurst, doing business as Farrar-Loomis Seed Co., as determined by order dated June 20, 1960, in Case No. 6555, is hereby revoked.


2. Farrar-Loomis Seed Company Warehouse Tariff No. One, California P.U.C. No. 1, is hereby canceled.




