OPINION AND ORDER

Hesperia Water Company seeks the lifting of restrictions against extending its water system, which were imposed by Decision No. 59281, to enable it to extend service to Hesperia County Fire Protection District located on Olive Street west of I Avenue in the location shown on the map, Exhibit A, attached to the application.

The water system installation would comprise approximately 715 feet of 4-inch pipe, a 3/4-inch service connection, a fire hydrant, miscellaneous valves and fittings, and the extension is proposed to be made under Section B of applicant's main extension rule applicable to extensions to serve individuals.

It is alleged that the proposed extension is inside applicant's general service area; the quality of service rendered existing customers will not be impaired; revenues of the Company will be increased and the service will not burden other ratepayers; and, unless the sought relief is granted, the fire protection district would be required to drill a new well and supply its own water supply.

The Commission staff has submitted Advice of Participation, dated August 16, 1966, stating that it is not opposed to the granting

of the authority requested and recommending that the matter be handled ex parte. A copy of said advice is received as Exhibit No. 1.

The Commission finds and concludes that public hearing is not necessary and the granting of the application is in the public interest, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Ordering paragraph 10 of Decision No. 59281 is modified and Hesperia Water Company is authorized to extend water service to Hesperia County Fire Protection District in the manner and location set forth in the application.

2. In all other respects Decision No. 59281 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
