ORDER REVOKING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

Paul Rieder and Luna M. Rieder, doing business as Rieder's Moving & Storage, possess a prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space at Sunnyvale.

Paul Rieder has informed the Commission by letter that the partnership desires to have its operative right canceled inasmuch as it only holds itself out to the public as a storage warehouse for secondhand household goods or effects.<sup>1</sup>

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the revocation of the prescriptive warehouse operative right as requested will not be adverse to the public interest. The Commission concludes that the prescriptive warehouse operative right should be revoked and the tariff applicable to the service thereunder should be canceled. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman possessed by Paul Rieder and Luna M. Rieder, doing business as Rieder's Moving & Storage, as determined by order dated July 26, 1960, in Case No. 6674, is hereby revoked.

<sup>1</sup> The term, "warehouseman", as used in Section 239 of the Public Utilities Code does not include corporations or persons storing only secondhand household goods or effects.

2. Paul Rieder and Luna M. Rieder, doing business as Rieder's Moving & Storage, Warehouse Tariff No. 1, Cal.P.U.C. No. 1, is hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Paul Rieder and Luna M. Rieder or to mail a certified copy thereof to them at their last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon Paul Rieder and Luna M. Rieder or after the above mailing to them unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for public hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
