ORDER REVOKING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

Sun Valley Supply Company, a corporation, possesses a prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space at Caruthers.

James H. Flanagan, Jr., attorney for Sun Valley Supply Company, informed the Commission by letter that the warehouseman has been inactive and defunct since about January, 1964, and requested that the operative right be terminated inasmuch as the storage involved was incidental to the cleaning, bagging and sale of beans and there had been no holding out to the public.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the revocation of the prescriptive warehouse operative right as requested will not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the operative right should be revoked and the tariff applicable to the service thereunder should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that:


1. The prescriptive operative right as a public utility warehouseman possessed by Sun Valley Supply Company, a corporation, as determined by order dated August 30, 1960, in Case No. 6936, is hereby revoked.


2. Jack L. Dawson, Agent, is hereby authorized and directed to cancel the participation of Sun Valley Supply Company, a corporation, from his Warehouse Tariff No. 38, Cal.P.U.C. No. 203, on file with the Commission, such cancellation to be made within ninety days after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public.


The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Sun Valley Supply Company, a corporation, or to mail a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records and to mail a copy of this order to Jack L. Dawson, Agent.


The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon Sun Valley Supply Company, a corporation, or after the above mailing to it unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for public hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.


