ORDER REVOKING WAREHOUSE OPERATIVE RIGHT

Cecil F. White, an individual, doing business as White Warehouse Company, possesses a certificate of public convenience and necessity as a public utility warehouseman for the operation of storage or warehouse floor space at Fresno.

Cecil F. White has informed the Commission by letter that he has not stored anything except cotton for the U.S. Government during his entire operation, that he ceased operation on or about October 1, 1965, and that he sold the premises to a tire company.

Cecil F. White having discontinued service as a public utility warehouseman without proper authority, the Commission finds that such discontinuance constitutes good cause for revocation of the certificate of public convenience and necessity involved and cancellation of the tariff applicable to the service thereunder.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a public utility warehouseman granted to Cecil F. White, an individual, doing business as White Warehouse Company, by Decision No. 65930, dated August 30, 1963, in Application No. 45699, is hereby revoked.
