ORDER

The Western Pacific Railroad Company is hereby authorized to construct two additional tracks at grade across Delaware Street, and to construct a lead track at grade across Massachusetts Street, in the City and County of San Francisco, at the locations described in the application.

It is alleged that Delaware Street and Massachusetts Street are not at present open to public use and travel. This order is not to be deemed authority for such opening.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
