ORDER EXTENDING TIME FOR PAYMENT OF FINE

Commission Decision No. 70718, issued herein May 17, 1966,
ordered the respondent to pay a fine of \$2,353.66 on or before
July 18, 1966.

Respondent has requested by letter, that the time allowed
to pay the fine be extended to December 1, 1966 in order to provide
sufficient time to bill and collect the remaining undercharges from
the shippers. Partial payments totaling \$1,409.53 have already
been received and \$944.53 is still due.

IT IS ORDERED that the time within which respondent Cal-
Freight, Inc., is ordered to pay the sum of \$944.53 pursuant to
paragraph 1 of the order in Decision No. 70718, dated May 17, 1966,
in Case No. 8250, is extended to December 1, 1966.
