ORDER FURTHER EXTENDING TIME

By letter dated September 20, 1966, respondent requests a further extension of time within which to pay the balance due on the fine imposed by ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 70434 dated March 8, 1966 and that the total amount of said fine be reduced by \$42.68. The balance due on the fine is \$402.77. The letter asserts that respondent has been unable to locate the shipper responsible for \$42.68 in undercharges and that he has filed a claim with the estate of the deceased shipper responsible for \$360.09 in undercharges. ✓

It appears to the Commission that respondent should be granted a further extension of time to April 10, 1967 within which to pay the balance of the fine imposed by ordering paragraph 1 and that the amount of said fine should be reduced by \$42.68.

IT IS ORDERED that the time limit for compliance with the requirements of ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 70434 dated March 3, 1966 is extended to and including April 10, 1967, and that the amount of the fine specified in said paragraph is reduced by \$42.68.

In all other respects Decision No. 70434 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
