## OPINION AND ORDER

Distance Table iNo． 5 contains the basis for detemining constmuctive mieages，which govern the distance rates in various minimu rato tarifts issued by the Comission．By the above petition Caiforaia Truckieg Association seeks to bave the definition of以上丨eage Dasing Point amended by including thenefn the term， ＂Jrnumbered Junction．＂

According to the petition，faliune to inciude unnmbered highway functions in the derinition of Mileage Besing Point creates an unreasonable and illogical basis for constructive mileage deter－ mination．Petitioner alleges that a situation has been inadvertentiy creatol，winich is not resposisive to the intent of the constructive mineage concept nor to the practices of carriers and shippers，and that no useful pumpose is sexved by the mileage designations between such points on the maps contained in the Distance Table uniess pro－ Visions for such points are made in the deffutton．Petitioner asserts that tine proposed change will create a tariff stmacture con－ sistent with actual practice and majerstandiag．

Copies of the verfrifed petition yere malled to various
charbers of comerce，siripper associations and carrier representatives on or about Argust 9，1966．The petition was Iisted on the Commis－ sion？s Daily Caleadar of Auguct 22，2966．No sojection to the grantsiof of the petstion bas been recelved．

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission fincos, that petitioner's proposal is reasonable and that the proposed amerdment of the involved mile will provide a just, reasonable and nondiscriminatory bacis for computing destances for use in applying diftance rates in the appilcable minimu rate tarifis. A public beaning is notinecessary. The Comission concluces that the petition should be granted:

In tine interest of tariff simplification, tine supplement to be Issued to Distance Tabie NO. 5 will incomporate the provisions of Supplement No.' 11.

II IS ORDERED that:

1. Distance Table No. 5 (Decision No. 66578, as amerded) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective November 19, 1966, Supplement No. 12 attached hereto and by ths refereace made a part hereof.
2. Tariff publications authorized to bo made by common campers as a result of the orcer herein may be made eifective not eariler than the tenth day after the effective date of this order, and may be made effective on not less than ten days notfce to the Comission and to the pubilc 1 If friled not later thon sixty days after the effective date of the distance tablo supplement incorporated in this order.
3. Comon comriers are authorized to adopt Supplement No. 12 to Distance Jable No. 5 as a basis for compating distances for use in applying distance rates in their comon carrien tarifis for the transportation of:
(a) comodities for whion minimm rates bave not been established, or
(b) comodities which are suoject to higher mates than, or more restrietive provisions than the mfoimum rates or provisions otherwise appicable.

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4. Como carriers, in establishing and maintaining the male authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizetons are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the rale published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing longand short-haul departures and to this order.
5. In all other respects; Decision ito. 66578, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
