In the Matter of the Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the construction at grade of industrial drill tracks in, upon and across Roseville Road and Orange Grove Avenue in the City of Planehaven, County of Sacramento, State of California.

ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to construct a drill track at grade across Roseville Road and across Orange Grove Avenue near Planehaven, Sacramento County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as Crossings Nos. A-97.3-C and A-97.8-C, respectively. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the road and avenue now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B) supplemented with automatic gate arms at Crossing No. A-97.3-C, and by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B) at Crossing No. A-97.8-C, respectively. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be

extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.
