O P I N I O N

M AND M Transfer Company, presently rendering service as a highway common carrier, requests authority to suspend service for the transportation of certain commodities between Union Carbide Corporation, located in Torrance, California, and other points in applicant's certificated area until June 1, 1967.

By Decision No. 70472 dated March 22, 1966, in Application No. 48217 applicant was authorized to suspend service on specified commodities on shipments originating at the Union Carbide Corporation plant until June 1, 1967. By the instant application applicant seeks to extend the number of such commodities.

It is alleged that the additional commodities, which primarily are aluminum products or alloys, were formerly shipped by Union Carbide from its Los Angeles facilities and are now being shipped from its plant in Torrance. Applicant will transport these shipments as a permitted carrier.

After consideration the Commission finds that the proposed suspension would not be adverse to the public interest and that public convenience and necessity do not require continuance of highway common carrier service by applicant for the commodities listed in the order herein. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Commencing with the effective date of the tariff filings authorized in ordering paragraph 2 hereof and concluding with June 1, 1967, M AND M Transfer Company may suspend service as a highway common carrier on shipments of the following commodities between Union Carbide Corporation, located in Torrance, California, and other points in applicant's certificated area.

- (3) Calcium-aluminum-silicon
- (4) Calcium-manganese-silicon
- (5) Cerium

- (8) Ferro-chrome
- (9) Ferro-cobalt-nickel
- (10) Ferro-manganese
- (11) Ferro-manganese-silicon
- (12) Ferro-molybdenum
- (13) Ferro-phosphorus
- (14) Ferro-silicon
- (15) Ferro-silicon-aluminum
- (16) Ferro-silicon-chrome, or Ferro-chrome-silicon
- (17) Ferro-titanium
- (18) Ferro-tungsten
- (19) Manganese-titanium

- (20) Silicon-manganese
- (21) Silicon-calcium
- (22) Silicon-zirconium
- (23) Zirconium-ferro-silicon
- (24) Zirconium-ferro-silicon-titanium

- (b) Carbide
- (c) Silicon
- (d) Metals, NOI, or Metal Alloys, NOI

and as to transportation of the following additional commodities between Reynolds Metals Company, located at 2315 Dominguez Avenue, Torrance, California, and destinations in Southern California:

- (a) Aluminum
  - (Bar
  - (Rod
- (b) Aluminum
  - (Sheet
  - (Plate
- (c) Aluminum wire
- (d) Foil, Aluminum W/O Paper Back or Backed with Paper weighing 30 lbs. or less
- (e) Foil, Aluminum, Backed with Paper weighing more than 30 lbs.
- (f) Cable, Electric, Aluminum
- (g) Pipe or Tubing, Aluminum, NOI
- (h) Labels, Paper and Foil Combined
- (i) Aluminum Sheet, Angle or Other Items Taking Same or Lower Rate
- (j) Aluminum Sheet, Angle, Rods, Bar, Rivets, Screws and Nuts
- (k) Aluminum Plates, Pans, Trays, NOI
- (l) Dishes or Cups, Foil or Sheet Nested or Nested Solid, With or Without Covers
- (m) Aluminum Extrusions NOIBN

2. After the effective date hereof and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public applicant shall amend its tariff, presently on file with this Commission to reflect the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
