SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Southern California Edison Company has requested, by letter of September 9, 1966, that ordering paragraph 2 of Decision No. 61754, dated April 4, 1961, in Application No. 42868, be modified to relieve it from the requirements of preparing and filing an annual financial report on that portion of its system known as Camino-Chambless substation and extension in San Bernardino County. Said letter is received herein as Exhibit I.

In granting this certificate of public convenience and necessity in said decision, this Commission recognized the fact that construction of the installation was not in accordance with applicant's filed tariffs and that applicant had a sizeable investment in the facilities. In order to prevent an uneconomical extension from being a burden on other ratepayers, applicant was ordered to keep independent financial records for this extension and to file an annual report thereon.

Reports were submitted for the years 1961 through 1965 showing annual revenue, expense and investment for rate-making adjustments. In the future applicant should be prepared to provide rate-making adjustments by special study when required.

After consideration, and good cause appearing, the Commission finds that applicant's request should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Southern California Edison, in the future, is relieved from the obligation to prepare and submit the annual financial report required by ordering paragraph 2 in Decision No. 61754.

2. Decision No. 61754 shall, in all other respects, remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
