ORDER DENYING SUSPENSION OF EFFECTIVE DATES

House Moving Contractors Association of California has filed a petition for the postponement or suspension of the effective dates of Decision Nos. 71337, 71338, 71339, 71340, 71341 and 71342. The Commission has considered each and every allegation of said petition. It appears that the said petition seeks a

suspension of the said decisions pending the disposition by the California Supreme Court of a petition for writ of review of Decision No. 70919. However, that petition for review was filed more than thirty days after Decision No. 71239 which denied rehearing of Decision No. 70919. Petitioner has never sought rehearing of Decision Nos. 71337 through 71342. Moreover, it is the Commission's opinion that the minimum rate tariffs modified by said Decisions Nos. 71337 through 71342 did not in any event apply to the movement of houses and that said Decision Nos. 71337 through 71342 were merely to remove any ambiguities concerning such position of the Commission. Therefore, no basis for the granting of the petition exists.

IT IS ORDERED, therefore, that the said petition for the postponement or suspension of the effective dates of Decision Nos. 71337, 71338, 71339, 71340, 71341 and 71342 is hereby denied.
