Decision No. 71591

BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of the City of Monterey, a municipal corporation, for authority for and approval of a public crossing of the extension of Park Avenue north of Del Monte Avenue in said City, across an existing track of the Southern Pacific Company.

ORDER

The City of Monterey is hereby authorized to construct Park Avenue at grade across a track of the Southern Pacific Company in the City of Monterey, Monterey County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. EE-125.2.

Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than 2 percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) augmented with automatic gate arms.

Applicant shall bear entire expense of construction and installation of automatic protection, also maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines. Maintenance cost of the automatic protection shall be borne by the applicant, pursuant to the provisions of Section 1202.2 of the Public Utilities Code.

This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not

complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
