Application of The Atchison, Topeka
and Santa Fe Railway Company, a
corporation, for authority to construct,
maintain and operate two additional
tracks across Valencia Avenue, and widen
Valencia Avenue, in the City of Tustin,
State of California.

O R D E R

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is hereby authorized to construct two additional tracks at grade and to widen the crossing of Valencia Avenue in the City of Tustin, Orange County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 2-178.3-C.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Width of crossing shall be not less than 64 feet, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two percent. Protection shall be by four Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B). Backlights may be omitted from the signals located on the median. Trains shall not be operated over the two additional tracks until such protection is placed in service.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
