ORDER

The Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to construct an additional industrial drill track at grade across Industry Circle in the City of La Mirada, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. BK-502.8-C.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width of 43 feet, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one percent in accordance with plan attached to the application. Protection shall be by existing two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
