OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 70676, dated March 24, 1966, in Application No. 48308, the Commission amended the operating authority of Mueller Truck Co. by excluding therefrom the following:

- "9. Sodium (Soda) Hypochlorite Solution originating at Los Angeles, and Pallets used in such transportation destined to Los Angeles."

It is alleged that said traffic actually is to and from Vernon and it is requested that the restriction be so amended.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Appendix A of Decision No. 53261 as heretofore amended is further amended by incorporating therein Second Revised Page 3, attached hereto, in revision of First Revised Page 3.

2. Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall amend its tariff on file with this Commission to reflect the action herein taken.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.

Applicant shall not transport any shipments of:

1. Used household goods and personal effects not packed in accordance with the crated property requirements set forth in Item No. 5 of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-B.
2. Automobiles, trucks and buses, viz.: new and used, finished or unfinished passenger automobiles, (including jeeps), ambulances, hearses and taxis; freight automobiles, automobile chassis, trucks, truck chassis, truck trailers, trucks and trailers combined, buses and bus chassis.
3. Livestock, viz.: bucks, bulls, calves, cattle, cows, dairy cattle, ewes, goats, hogs, horses, kids, lambs, oxen, pigs, sheep, sheep camp outfits, sows, steers, stags or swine.
- * 4. Commodities requiring the use of special refrigeration or temperature control in specially designed and constructed refrigerator equipment.
5. Liquids, compressed gases, commodities in semi-plastic form and commodities in suspension in liquids in bulk, in tank trucks, tank trailers, tank semitrailers or a combination of such highway vehicles.
6. Commodities when transported in bulk in dump trucks or in hopper-type trucks.
7. Commodities when transported in motor vehicles equipped for mechanical mixing in transit.
8. Logs.
9. Sodium (Soda) Hypochlorite Solution originating at Vernon, and Pallets used in such transportation destined to Vernon.

*Does not apply for shipments between the San Diego Territory, on the one hand, and the City of Los Angeles, on the other hand, serving no intermediate points.
