ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE AUTHORITY

By Decision No. 62414 dated August 15, 1961, in Application No. 43541 and by Decision No. 68294 dated November 30, 1964, in Application No. 47012, Manuel Martinez, doing business as Chino Transit Lines, was granted passenger stage operative rights authorizing service between Pomona, Chino, Los Serranos, the California Institution for Men, the California Institution for Women and the Youth Training School of the California Youth Authority and intermediate points, and it appearing that during the month of April 1966, the passenger stage service theretofore conducted by Manuel Martinez between the aforementioned points pursuant to the foregoing described operative right was discontinued, that Manuel Martinez is now deceased, and that since May 15, 1966, there has been no evidence on file with this Commission showing adequate protection against liability imposed by law for payment of damage for personal injury or property damage, as required by General Orders Nos. 101-A or 101-B; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the passenger stage operative rights, created by Decision No. 62414 in Application No. 43541 and Decision No. 68294 in Application No. 47012 are hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Manuel Martinez are hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Manuel Martinez's son, Rudolph Martinez or to mail a certified copy thereof to Rudolph Martinez at 12445 Baca Avenue, Chino, California, last known address as shown in the Commission's records. Service shall also be made on, or a certified copy of this order mailed to Bank of America NT and SA, Special Administrator of the Estate of Manuel Salvador Martinez, 116 East Fourth Street, Pomona, California.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon Rudolph Martinez and the Bank of America NT and SA or after the above mailing to Rudolph Martinez, and the Bank of America NT and SA as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission written response to this order requesting public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
