O R D E R

County of El Dorado is hereby authorized to construct Indian Creek Road at grade across a track of Southern Pacific Company near Shingle Springs, El Dorado County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. AH-137.9.

Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-four feet and grades of approach not greater than three percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B) supplemented with automatic gate arms.

Applicant shall bear entire expense of construction and installation of automatic protection, also maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines. Maintenance costs of the automatic protection shall be borne by the applicant, pursuant to the provisions of Section 1202.2 of the Public Utilities Code.

Upon completion of Crossing No. AH-137.9 and upon the installation of the automatic protection at Crossing No. AH-137.9, the crossing at Milepost 137.8, about 180 feet southwesterly shall be abandoned and effectively closed by Southern Pacific Company. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
