ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Decision No. 71575, dated November 23, 1966, in this matter ordered respondent, The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company, to make revised tariffs effective for all affected services on and after January 1, 1967.

By petition dated December 2, 1966, respondent requested deferment of the effective date of the tariffs for toll rates and toll and message unit mileage measurement from January 1, 1967 to January 30, 1967. Respondent indicated this delay to be necessary to complete conversion of traffic operating position records to the new rate structure, to permit time for checking these records and to perform operator training. We find the requested delay in effective date is reasonable.

IT IS ORDERED that the effective date of the following tariff schedules ordered in Decision No. 71575 shall be deferred from January 1, 1967 to January 30, 1967:

Schedules Nos. 6T, 7T, 53T, 56T, 58T, 82T, 89T, 90T, 92T and 96T
