ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By ordering paragraph No. 1 of Decision No. 71492, dated November 1, 1966, herein, Central California Traction Company, a corporation, was ordered to install radio communication in all locomotives and cabooses in addition to certain fixed locations, and in at least one mobile unit by not later than December 31, 1966.

By letter dated November 15, 1966, Central California Traction Company has advised that it will not be possible to install the radio equipment by December 31, 1966, due to government priorities causing a delay in delivery of the necessary parts. It is requested that a reasonable extension of time be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that the time within which to install radio equipment pursuant to Decision No. 71492 is hereby extended to April 1, 1967.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
