ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

W. Ray James, doing business as James Van Lines, possesses certificates of public convenience and necessity to transport used household goods and related articles and new furniture between various points in California.

W. Ray James has not maintained tariffs on file with this Commission covering transportation of the above commodities under the certificates involved. Moreover, Wyman C. Knapp, attorney for W. Ray James, has informed the Commission that the carrier has not

engaged in transportation under these certificated rights for several years and has no intention of doing so. According to the attorney, the carrier has no objection to cancelling such rights.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the revocation of the aforementioned certificates of public convenience and necessity would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the certificates should be revoked.

IT IS ORDERED that:


1. The certificates of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier acquired by and granted to W. Ray James by Decisions Nos. 35699, 40083 and 41045, dated August 18, 1942, March 25, 1947 and December 17, 1947, in Applications Nos. 24924, 28071 and 28529, respectively, are hereby revoked.




The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon W. Ray James or after the above mailing to him unless before such effective date there shall have


been filed with this Commission a written request for public hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
