ORDER EXTENDING PERIOD OF SUSPENSION

It appearing that on June 28, 1966, the Commission issued an order of suspension and investigation which suspended the effective date of Rate A. 3. contained in Original Cal. P.U.C. Sheet No. 16-T and Rate B. 3. contained in Original Cal. P.U.C. Sheet No. 17-T, which provide a new offering of one-way selective tone-only paging message and receiver rental service, filed by American Mobile Radio Inc. under Advice Letter No. 3, until November 5, 1966, and

It further appearing that a decision in the matter could not be rendered by said date of November 5, 1966, and

The Commission having found that the period of suspension of said tariff sheets should be extended; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the suspension of the effective date of Rate A. 3. contained in Original Cal. P.U.C. Sheet No. 16-T and Rate B. 3. contained in Original Cal. P.U.C. Sheet No. 17-T, filed

by American Mobile Radio Inc. under Advice Letter No. 3, is extended to and including May 3, 1967, unless otherwise hereafter ordered.

The Secretary of the Commission is directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served forthwith upon American Mobile Radio Inc.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
