SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

In Decision No. 71162, dated August 23, 1966, the Commission authorized Central Utilities, Inc. (seller), to transfer its water system to Aldercroft Heights County Water District (buyer) and to discontinue service in the Aldercroft Heights area. The decision provided that the order therein would become effective upon further order of the Commission, to be issued after receipt of certain stipulations by buyer to protect the interests of customers outside the district boundaries.

Buyer has filed the requisite document in compliance with Decision No. 71162.

IT IS ORDERED that the effective date of this order and of the order in Decision No. 71162 is the date hereof.
