ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

Leo Lomski, doing business as Showboat Transportation Company, possesses a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a common carrier by vessel for the transportation of passengers between San Carlos and Redwood City, on the one hand, and Candlestick Park in San Francisco, on the other hand.

Leo Lomski has informed the Commission by letter that he ceased operations in October of 1962 and completely closed down in December of 1962.

Leo Lomski having discontinued service as a common carrier by vessel without proper authority, the Commission finds that such failure constitutes good cause for revocation of the operative right involved and cancellation of the tariff applicable to the service thereunder.

IT IS ORDERED that:


1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a common carrier by vessel granted to Leo Lomski by Decision No. 61768, dated April 4, 1961, in Application No. 43141 is hereby revoked.


2. Leo Lomski, doing business as Showboat Transportation Company, Local Passenger Tariff Cal.P.U.C. No. 1 is hereby canceled.


The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Leo Lomski or mail a certified copy thereof to him at his last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon Leo Lomski or after the above mailing to him unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for public hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
