BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of ALVIN J. HOFFMAN, dba PAN TERRA WATER COMPANY, for an order under Sections 851-853 of the Public Utilities Code authorizing the sale, disposition and assignment to the City of Morgan Hill, a municipal corporation, of the water system, permits, franchises and assets necessary and useful in the performance of duties of said corporation in providing water service to the public.

SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Commission, by Decision No. 71671, dated December 6, 1966, authorized Alvin J. Hoffman to transfer the Pan Terra water system to the City of Morgan Hill and to discontinue service. The decision provides that the order therein shall become effective upon further order of the Commission, to be issued after compliance with paragraphs 3 and 5 of the order.

On December 23, 1966, seller filed with the Commission a document in compliance with paragraph 3 of the order in Decision No. 71671. On December 30, 1966, there was filed with the Commission the stipulation required by paragraph 5 of said decision.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the effective date of this order and of the order in Decision No. 71671 shall be the date hereof.
