HOFFMAN, dba PAN TERRA WATER COMPANY, for authority to extend service and for an order modifying Decision No. 65102, dated March 19, 1963, and Decision No. 66042, dated September 24, 1963, to permit water service throughout certificated area and to secure adoption of New Tariff Service Area Map and to make Rates and Rules authorized by Decision 65102 (paragraph 3) effective as to certificated area.

ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Applicant has requested authority to extend public utility water service to Unit 2 within the area, near Morgan Hill, originally certificated to applicant by prior Commission orders (Decision No. 65102, dated March 19, 1963 and Decision No. 66042, dated September 24, 1963, in Application No. 44403).

The Commission has recently authorized applicant to transfer his water system to the City of Morgan Hill (Decision No. 71671, dated December 6, 1966, in Application No. 48912), and has stated, in its order conditionally authorizing that transfer, that upon issuance of a supplemental order fixing the effective date of the transfer authorization, an order dismissing the instant application for extension of service would be contemporaneously issued.

The Commission, by supplemental order issued this date, has established the effective date of Decision No. 71671 as December 30, 1966.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the above-entitled and numbered application be and it hereby is dismissed.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
