Application of the City of San Jose, a municipal corporation of the State of California, for permission to widen an existing crossing at grade of The Western Pacific Railroad Company's railroad tracks at Park Avenue, in the County of Santa Clara, State of California (P.U.C. Crossing No.4G-22.7).

O R D E R


The City of San Jose is hereby authorized to widen the existing crossing at grade of Park Avenue across the tracks of The Western Pacific Railroad Company in the City of San Jose, County of Santa Clara at the location and substantially as shown by plan (Exhibit A) attached to the application, identified as Crossing No. 4G-22.7.

Width of the crossing shall be not less than ninety five feet and grades of approach not greater than shown on plan (Exhibit A) attached to the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall consist of 4 Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) the center two to be placed on a median strip, or two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals supplemented by flashing light signals on cantilever arms if there is insufficient room for a median strip.

Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto and a copy of said agreement approved by The Western Pacific Railroad Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
