SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Ordering paragraph 6 of Decision No. 66891, dated March 3, 1964, provided that if the applicants completed the installation of a second well and pump prior to January 1, 1965, the Commission would by supplemental order authorize them to file a schedule of higher rates set forth in Appendix B to that order.

By letter dated August 15, 1966, applicants advised the Commission that the new well and pumping equipment had been installed. Field investigation by a staff engineer confirms that the required installations have been completed and are satisfactory; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Timothy Monson and Reta Monson, doing business as Greenfield Village Water Company, are authorized to file with this Commission, after the effective date of this order, the schedules of rates set forth in Appendix B of .

Decision No. 66891. The effective date of these tariff sheets shall be four days after the date of filing.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
